Everyone Will Meet Jesus Christ

Jesus Christ is a real person! "Jesus" comes from a Hebrew word meaning "Jehovah the Saviour" and in Greek it is Jesus. "Christ" means anointed, the Messiah. We have then in Jesus Christ Jehovah the Saviour, the anointed Messiah.
